Seven year old Jodie was withdrawn, anxious and guarded when she and her mother, Claire, were referred to Welcare. While Jodie's childhood had begun as a happy one, her mother had sadly been diagnosed with MS. This big change was affecting their emotional well-being and their relationship was suffering.

On top of the physical symptoms - pain, exhaustion, difficulty walking - Claire developed depression and was struggling to relate to and support Jodie.

Thanks to our donors, we were able to match Jodie with one of our fantastic volunteer mentors



who gave her the time and attention she needed and helped her build confidence.

We were also able to help Claire access the appropriate counselling and health support she needed, helping her to focus on gaining control of her new life and understand the best way she could now provide for her daughter.
