Our staff, volunteers and supporters have been especially busy over the last few weeks to ensure that the children and families we work with have the very best Christmas pos Our Toy Choosing events in Bromley and East Surrey are designed to give parents dignit select the most appropriate gift for their child. This has been a year packed full of progression and new initiatives. In 2017 we have:

- Provided a wonderful new Children's Garden at our East Surrey Centre in Redhill
